

About CSG

I. Company profile

Established on December 29, 2002, CSG stands as a leading force in Southern China's energy sector, overseeing the investment, construction, operation, and management of the power grid of Southern China. Beyond its functions of electricity procurement, sales, trading, and dispatch, CSG engages in both domestic and international investment, financing, foreign trade circulation management, international cooperation, foreign engineering contracting, foreign labor cooperation, and other businesses.

CSG operates one of the world's most complex and advanced power grids with the highest proportion of clean electricity. The grid spans five provinces and regions and connects seamlessly to the power networks of Hong Kong, Macao, and Southeast Asia. Serving an area of over 1 million square kilometers, CSG powers a population of 272 million people and provides electricity to 116 million customers. Recognized among the Fortune Global 500 companies for two decades, CSG currently ranks 78th globally.

As China's pioneering power grid company to expand internationally, CSG is the designated entity for the Greater Mekong Subregion energy cooperation under the State Council's guidance. In alignment with the Belt and Road Initiative, CSG continues to foster cross-border grid interconnectivity, enhancing international power exchanges and collaboration across neighboring countries. By the end of 2023, CSG had achieved a cumulative international electricity trade volume of 70.712 billion kWh.

II. Main platform for overseas businesses

(I) China Southern Power Grid International Co., Ltd. and China Southern Power Grid International (HK) Co., Ltd.

China Southern Power Grid International Co., Ltd. ("CSG International"), a wholly-owned subsidiary of CSG, operates under the model of "one team, two brands" alongside China Southern Power Grid International Co., Ltd. ("CSG International Hong Kong"). Aligning with CSG's global growth strategy, CSG International is dedicated to advancing an international development platform, supporting CSG's overseas investments and operations, and serving as a trailblazer in the international market, an integrator of global resources, an operator of international assets, and a reliable power supplier to Hong Kong and Macao.

CSG International is mainly responsible for the operation of assets of transnational power transmission and transformation projects, foreign technical cooperation, international trade, etc. It has carried out the preliminary research and development of more than 40 projects around the world and has established profound cooperation and partnerships with many famous enterprises and organizations both at home and abroad. At present, CSG International's overseas power supply and grid assets are distributed in three continents, namely Asia, Europe, Latin America, as well as Hong Kong and Macao of China.

(II) CSG Lancang-Mekong International Co., Ltd.

As the regional headquarters for CSG's international business in the Lancang-Mekong region, CSG Lancang-Mekong International Co., Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as "CSG-LMI") is the primary platform for CSG to fulfill its role as the Chinese implementation unit of the Energy Cooperation in the Greater Mekong Subregion (GMS) and the strategic deployment of the high-quality construction of the Belt and Road Initiative. CSG-LMI mainly oversees CSG's energy and power development, investment, construction, operations, and service initiatives across five key Lancang-Mekong countries: Vietnam, Laos, Cambodia, Myanmar, and Thailand.








Cultural Integration More dynamic international exchanges and cooperation

Peruvian President Boruarte Meets with Key Leaders of the Company





II. Communication and cooperation

Establishment of a Mechanism for Power Utility Summit among the Lancang-Mekong Countries

In 2014, CSG initiated the Power Utility Summit of the Lancang-Mekong Countries, receiving enthusiastic support from the Vietnam Electricity Group, the Electricity du Laos (EDL), the Electricity Generating Authority of Thailand, the Ministry of Electricity and Energy (Myanmar), and the Electricity Authority of Cambodia. As of the end of September 2024, the Summit has been held for nine consecutive sessions.



CSG-TEPCO-KPX Summit

In September 2016, CSG hosted the first China, Japan and the Republic of Korea (ROK) Power Industry Summit in Guangzhou, and the three parties signed the Memorandum of Understanding on High-Level Communication and Liaison Mechanism, deciding to host the Summit on a regular rotational basis. As of the end of September 2024, the summit has been held for seven consecutive years.



Establishment of a Mechanism for the China-Invested Enterprise Power Industry Summit for Lancang-Mekong Cooperation (LMC)

CSG launched the initiative of the summit mechanism for the China-Invested Enterprise Power Industry Summit for Lancang-Mekong Cooperation (LMC) in 2019, inviting relevant national power regulatory authorities, Chinese-funded enterprises mainly involved in Lancang-Mekong Cooperation, and domestic financial institutions to hold regular forums and exchange meetings on topics related to Lancang-Mekong Cooperation. As of the end of September 2024, the Summit has been held four sessions.



Establishment of a Mechanism for the "Lancang-Mekong Week" Activities and the 2024 LMC Spring Reception

Since 2016, CSG has been conducting in-depth exchanges with Lancang-Mekong countries on connectivity and "small yet beautiful" livelihood projects during the week of March 23 every year (Lancang-Mekong Week).

From April 19 to 20, 2024, the 6th Latin American Energy Summit (one of the highest-level summits in the energy industry in Latin America) was held in Santiago, the capital of Chile. 




Lantern Lighting Ceremony on the Banks of the Lancang and Mekong Rivers Celebrates Dai New Year



IV. Technical Exchanges

Active Engagement in International Standards Development and Global Representation

On January 5, 2024, the inaugural meeting of the International Organization for Standardization (ISO) Technical Committee on Mechanical Energy Storage convened in Guangzhou. This establishment marks a historic milestone as the first technical committee dedicated to energy storage since ISO's inception in 1947, symbolizing a significant step towards the internationalization of China's standards within the mechanical energy storage sector. During this conference, it was announced that the secretariat for the ISO Technical Committee on Mechanical Energy Storage would be hosted within CSG.

Since 2020, CSG has actively contributed to the publication of 25 international standards (IEC/ISO standards), including leadership roles in several initiatives. One of its experts currently chairs ISO/TC 346, while four emerging professionals have recently been appointed as Chinese representatives among the IEC's young experts. Additionally, CSG's experts have served as members of the expert committees 64 times across various international standardization organizations or international academic organizations, including the IEC, ISO, and IEEE.





Promoting sustainable fisheries development


The Laos Nam Tha River Company under CSG International has set up a special fund for the protection of the ecological environment of the river basin and continuously carries out ecological protection activities. Since the Laos Nam Tha River Company operated its No. 1 hydropower station, it has continued to carry out fish breeding and releasing activities in the reservoir area. In 2019, then Mr. Bounkong, Governor of Bokeo Province, visited the hydropower station and released 80,000 fish fry with the staff. So far, the hydropower station has released over 100,000 fish fry.



Use of technology

Protecting the ecology along the route with electric wires

The project of external power supply for the Laos section of the China-Laos Railway is the first power grid BOT project in Laos. Areas that the China-Laos Railway and its power supply project pass through are covered with dense forests and they are in relatively intact natural environmental protection. The Company combined a variety of mature technical means, such as high-low-leg iron towers, to reduce the damage to the ecological environment caused by engineering construction.








Enhanced Well-being Enriching lives for the community

Lao Tianrui (the first one from the left of the first row) is one of the first drivers of the "Lancang" CRH train on the China-Laos Railway. Funded by the Company, Tianrui used to study in China. After graduation, when the China-Laos Railway was about to be opened to traffic, Tianrui was recruited as a staff member and he officially became one of the first drivers of the CRH train after a few months of study and training.




Generously providing internship opportunities for local university students

Focus on the well-being of local people's livelihoods

Successfully complete the resettlement of migrants from China and Laos, focusing on improving local livelihoods through hydropower construction

The scale of resettlement under Nam Tha Power Company Hydropower Station Project in Laos is equivalent to resettling a large megawatt power plant, involving 9263 people from 38 villages, including villages in the Park ou County of Bokeo Province and Nalae County of Luang Namtha Province.

The Company fully respects the local customs and culture and works with the local government to make special programs and detailed resettlement plans. After four years, the resettlement was completed, and a new beautiful home was built for nearly 10,000 migrants.

Critical events in land acquisition and resettlement

March 2014

Nam Tha Power Company under CSG International and the Laos Power Company signed the Resettlement Service Agreement.(RSA) to fully carry out work on compensation for land acquisition for project construction and resettlement.

July 2016

The Hardmouak settlement was completed before the main flood season.(566 households) and Tavanh settlement (299 households).was completed and the relocation of 13 villages affected by the floods was completed as well as planned.

April 2018

The last Buddhist statue in Khonkham Village transferred to the settlement marked the completion of the resettlement of 9263 people from 38 villages in 11 relocation sites.

October 2014

The resettlement was officially started. Combining the local climatic and geographical conditions, the resettlement was organized in a scientific manner, and three low-lying old villages in Park ou County were selected as the first destination for resettlement.

August 2016

Thanks to the timely resettlement, all the villagers in the reservoir area safely escaped from a severe flood that occurred in the Nam Tha River. the flooding would have caused irreparable damage to the village if the village had not been resettled in time.



Helping migrants in the reservoir area to get rid of poverty

Together with the local government, the Company has developed livelihood restoration plans for the migrants, which has lifted many villagers out of long-standing poverty.



Story:

Migrant resettlement has realized Hilo's big dream



Hilo is a woman in her 40s from Zengen village. Before the resettlement, she had lived in a thatched cottage for a long time, using candles for light and unpurified river water for living, leading a poor life of farming and bartering.

In addition to improving the basic living conditions following the relocation, the village's infrastructure has also improved, particularly since the road was built, which fundamentally altered the prehistoric methods of trading commodities with other communities along the river. Today, Hilo's life is getting easier and better, as vendors regularly come to buy fabric and other agricultural products.

"I'm very grateful to CSG for caring so much about our lives in addition to helping us build a new house. In the past, we didn't grow mushrooms for a living; instead, we primarily relied on farming, which was very dependent on the weather. after training and practicing, I have gained local recognition as a mushroom-growing specialist and my family's quality of life is improving as a result of my ability to fully survive using my skills."

Full of fragrance of friendship

"The Champa flower is the national flower of Laos. It symbolizes holiness and nobility. In 2015, the Company officially named and initiated the "Champa Flower" Charity Program, and carried out some fine public welfare events, such as donating money to schools and caring for the vulnerable, which was widely recognized by all sectors of Laotian society. The Prime Minister of Laos awarded CSG International with a development medal, the provincial government of Bokeo awarded CSG International with a "special award for education development" for two consecutive years, the China–Laos Friendship Association sent a letter of appreciation, and local mainstream media such as Laos National Television praised CSG's contribution to deepening the traditional friendship between China and Laos.





In April 2019, the CPC and the Laos People's Revolutionary Party signed a five-year Action Plan between the Communist Party of China and the Laos People's Revolutionary Party on Building a Community of Shared Future between China and Laos.

The Company promptly responded to the action plan's appeal by constructing two "China-Laos Friendship Schools" for the villages of Wangli and Hanan in Pavoudong County, Bokeo Province, Laos. The Bokeo Provincial Government approved these schools in November 2020. Approximately 500 school-age children in the nearby villages receive quality education from those schools, which was highly appreciated by the Prime Minister of Laos.

New football field

On the eve of June 1, 2024, International Children's Day, the standard football field of Vangleck Village Primary School built with the assistance of the Company was officially delivered, which settled the concern for the poor sports ground, and children can have a rest and play on the green sports ground after studying.



The classes were frequently canceled because the original school was dilapidated, the structure leaked, and occasionally the timbers broke. There were only 30 students in three grades of elementary school and only two classrooms. The new school is now incredibly dependable with a variety of teaching appliances, and the student body has grown to over 100 with the addition of a kindergarten.


